User Guide

Push to Talk calls

Find your Push to Talk number

1. From the Home screen, press the **Send** key.
2. Press the **Menu** key.
3. Click **Status**.

Your Push to Talk number appears in the format `<AreaID>*<NetworkID>*<MemberID>`.

Send a call alert

You can send a call alert to notify a contact that you want to start a Push to Talk call.

1. Perform one of the following actions:
 - From the Home screen, press the **Push to Talk** key. Highlight a contact. Press the **Menu** key. Click **Alert**.
 - From the Home screen or in the phone application, type a Push to Talk number in the format `<AreaID>*<NetworkID>*<MemberID>`. Click **Alert**.
 - From the Home screen or in the phone application, type part of a contact name. Highlight a contact or Push to Talk number. Press the **Menu** key. Click **Alert**.
2. Press the **Push to Talk** key.

Answer a call alert or Push to Talk call

1. In a call alert or during a Push to Talk call, press and hold the **Push to Talk** key.
2. Perform any of the following actions:
 - To speak to the contact, press and hold the **Push to Talk** key. Wait for the sound before you speak.
 - To listen to the contact, release the **Push to Talk** key.

Defer a call alert

If you do not want to respond to a call alert immediately, you can save it for later.

In a call alert, click **Queue**.

The call alert appears in a message list as an unopened message.

To respond to the call alert, open the call alert message. Press the **Menu** key. Click **Alert**.

Turn off Push to Talk notifications

1. From the Home screen, press the **Send** key.
2. Press the **Menu** key.
3. Click **Options**.
4. Click **PTT**.
5. Perform one of the following actions:
 - To turn off all Push to Talk notifications, change the **Phone Only** field to **Yes**. All data services provided by your wireless service provider, including email messages and browsing, become unavailable.
 - To turn off individual Push to Talk notifications, change one or more **Silence** fields to **Yes**.
6. Press the **Menu** key.
7. Click **Save**.

Callers receive a notification that you are not available to receive Push to Talk calls.

Make a Push to Talk call

1. Perform one of the following actions:
 - From the Home screen, press the **Push to Talk** key. Click a contact or Push to Talk number. Press the **Push to Talk** key.
 - From the Home screen or in the phone application, type part of a contact name. Highlight a contact or Push to Talk number. Press the **Push to Talk** key.
 - From the Home screen or in the phone application, type a Push to Talk number in the format `<AreaID>*<NetworkID>*<MemberID>`. Press the **Push to Talk** key.
2. Perform any of the following actions:
 - To speak to your contact, press and hold the **Push to Talk** key. Wait for the sound before you speak. Continue to hold the **Push to Talk** key while you speak.
 - To listen to your contact, release the **Push to Talk** key.

To end the call, press the **End** key. If you wait for a short period of time, the call should end automatically.

About Group PTT calls and Talkgroup calls

If you want to communicate with multiple Push to Talk contacts, you can make a group call using Group PTT or by making a Talkgroup call. A Group PTT call includes up to 20 Push to Talk contacts that you specify in a call list that you create. Your wireless service provider must support Group PTT calls. A Talkgroup call is a group

call between members of a group that your wireless service provider creates and that you join. To make or receive a Talkgroup call, your wireless service provider must support Talkgroup calls and you must be a member of the Talkgroup. You must join the Talkgroup before you can speak to the group. You can only join one Talkgroup at a time.

All members of the group call listen during the call, but only one member can speak at a time.

Join a Talkgroup

1. In the phone application, type **#** followed by the number of the Talkgroup you want to join.
2. Click **Join**.

Make a Talkgroup call

To perform this task, you must join the Talkgroup .

1. From the Home screen, press the **Send** key.
2. Perform one of the following actions:
 - Click a Talkgroup number.
 - Type **#** (number sign) followed by the Talkgroup number.
3. Press the **Push to Talk** key.

Push to Talk contacts

Preview and send your contact information

In the contact list, perform any of the following actions:

- To preview your contact information before you send it, press the **Menu** key. Click **Preview My Info**.
- To send your contact information, highlight a contact. Press the **Menu** key. Click **Send My Info <name of contact>**. Press the **Push to Talk** key.

Send your contact information automatically

1. From the Home screen, press the **Send** key.
2. Press the **Menu** key.
3. Click **Options**.
4. Click **PTT**.
5. Change the **Auto Send My Info** field to **On**.

Stop receiving contact information messages

You can stop receiving the contact information messages that appear in the messages application when you make a Push to Talk call.

1. From the Home screen, press the **Send** key.
2. Press the **Menu** key.
3. Click **Options**.
4. Click **PTT**.
5. Change the **Auto Receive My Info** field to **Off**.
